06 BLACKLISTING OF M/S JAI HIND SECURITY SERVICES

Reference GEM online Bid no. BID GEM/2025/B/4340386 dated 13/12/2023 (Tender NIT No. 10/8/MSW/Garbage Vehicle dated 13/12/2023, CBR. No. 03 dated 31/01/2024 and Cantonment Board Chakrata letter No. 10/8/Garbage vehicle 30, letter No. 10/8/Garbage vehicle 37 read with mail from M/s Jai Hind Security Services dated 15/06/2024

Office report

The GeM Bid No. GEM/2023/B/4340386 was selected as L1 (System Run) by the GeM Portal and was approved by the Board vide CBR No. 03 dated 31/01/2024 for hiring a firm/agency for the transportation of segregated municipal waste (loading, transportation, and unloading as per MSW Rules 2016, MSW Rules 2020, and their amendments from time to time) from army and civil areas to the trenching ground of the Chakrata Cantonment Board located in MES Line, Chakrata.

Accordingly, a supply order was issued to M/s Jai Hind Security Services. As per available records, M/s Jai Hind Security Services initiated a trial run of the vehicle to provide services to the Board. However, upon inspection, it was found that the vehicles did not have proper compartments for the collection of waste as per the MSW Rules.

To ensure compliance with MSW Rules 2016 and MSW Rules 2020, certain modifications were verbally suggested by the Board to improve serviceability in the Cantonment. The firm gave positive consent to these suggestions. However, thereafter, M/s Jai Hind Security Services neither provided any of the services mentioned in the GEM tender nor communicated any reason for their absence.

Consequently, the Cantonment Board Chakrata, vide letter No. 10/8/MSW/Garbage Vehicle/30 dated 14/06/2024, directed M/s Jai Hind Security Services to submit an explanation for their non-provision of services and absence, and to explain why the contract should not be terminated and the security deposit forfeited, besides initiating the blacklisting process.

In response, instead of submitting valid reasons and modifying the vehicle to comply with MSW Rules 2016 and MSW Rules 2020, M/s Jai Hind Security Services submitted a vague reply, blaming the Board for the non-acceptance of the vehicle, which was completely inadequate for garbage collection.

It is pertinent to mention that point (4) of the Tender Document clearly states: "The Bidder/Firms/Agency will strictly follow the MSW Rules 2016, MSW Rules 2000, and its sub-rules and amendments from time to time."

Moreover, several efforts were made by this office to establish communication with M/s Jai Hind Security Services. In a recent event, when the Office Superintendent contacted the firm, the representative of M/s Jai Hind Security Services conducted the conversation in an unprofessional manner, blaming the members of the Board and even abusing the Office Superintendent instead of resolving the matter.

In view of the firm's non-serviceability, willful negligence in complying with MSW Rules 2016 and MSW Rules 2020, and unprofessionalism, the Cantonment Board Chakrata, vide letter No. 10/8/MSW/Garbage Vehicle/37 dated 17/08/2024, granted a final opportunity to M/s Jai Hind Security Services to commence services as awarded by the Cantonment Board Chakrata vide 10/1/Garbage Vehicle dated 07/02/2024. The firm was directed to establish necessary liaison with the Cantonment Board Chakrata and was informed that in the event of non-compliance within seven days from the receipt of this notice, the tender would be terminated, the security deposit forfeited, and the blacklisting process initiated against the firm.

As no reply or representation has been received in this office to date, the matter is now placed before the Board, along with all supporting documents, for the blacklisting of the firm.

Res.06 Board considered the matter and resolved to put-up the matter first for termination of the contract with the firm in the next Board meeting.

07 DRAFT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BYE-LAWS OF CANTONMENT BOARD

To consider the direction issued by the PDDE CC, Lucknow Cantt vide letter No.54653/SWMR-2000/Cantt/VIII/ dated 26/07/2024.

For the management of solid waste in Chakrata Cantonment, in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, the Chakrata Cantonment Board, after approval of the Board vide CBR No. 07 dated 30.11.2022, submitted the final draft of the Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws 2024 to the Government of India for publication. The proposed bye-laws, duly vetted by the Ministry of Law, were then published in the e-Gazette of the Government of India. In line with the procedure and directions contained in the referred letter, the Chakrata Cantonment Board displayed the bye-laws on its official website and notice board. Furthermore, the Board published the notification in two local newspapers, namely Dainik Jagran and Amar Ujala, on 31.07.2024, to invite public objections. In response, the office of the Cantonment Board Chakrata received the following objections:

All the objections received, have to be examined in light of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. The relevant rules are reproduced below:

" Rule 4. Duties of Waste generators -

(2) No waste generator shall throw, burn or bury the solid waste generated by him, on streets, open public spaces outside his premises or in the drain or water bodies.

(3) All waste generators shall pay such user fee for solid waste management, as specified in the bylaws of the local bodies."

Rule 15. Duties and responsibilities of local authorities and village Panchayats of census towns and urban agglomerations. – The local authorities and Panchayats shall, -

(f) Prescribe from time to time user fee and deem appropriate and collect the fee from the waster generators on its own or through authorised agency;

(zg)(ix) Pay monthly user fee or charges to waste collectors or local bodies or any other person authorised by the local body for sustainability of solid waste management.

After careful examination of the representation in the light of the above rules of The Solid Waste Management Rules 2016, it is found that there is no merit in the objections raised in the serial No 2 and 3 and are liable to be rejected. However, objection raised by the nominated member about exorbitant rate in serial No. 03 (Commercial establishments, shops, eating places) of Chapter X, First Schedule i.e. User Fee for Solid Waste Management, matter is put up before the board for taking a suitable decision.

Accordingly, all the objections are put up before the Board for disposal and for final approval of the Chakrata Cantonment Board Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws 2024 for onward submission through PDDECC.

Resolution:07 All objections were considered and discussed at length. After examining all the facts and rules, it is found that there is no merit in the objections mentioned at Serial Nos. 2 and 3 of the agenda. Therefore, it is resolved to reject them. However, regarding the objection raised at Serial No. 3 by the nominated member, it is resolved that, based on local circumstances, the user fee for solid waste management mentioned in Schedule-I, Serial No. 3, should be revised from Rs. 500 to Rs. 250. The Board further resolved that, after making the necessary corrections, the final Solid Waste Management Bye-laws for Chakrata Cantonment be sent for publication in the Gazette.

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08 FINALIZATION LAND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF MULTI STOREY PARKING.

Reference CBR No. 14 dated 28/07/2023.

Office report:

During a recent visit to the Office of the Cantonment Board Chakrata, Shri Satpal Maharaj, the Hon'ble Minister for Tourism, Government of Uttarakhand, dedicated significant time to discussing the development of Chakrata Cantonment with the aim of enhancing tourist flow and boosting the region's economy.

During the discussion, the issue of inadequate parking facilities was raised. In response, the Hon'ble Minister agreed to construct a multi-storey parking facility in Chakrata Cantonment under the State Government's initiative. However, he directed the Cantonment Board to first identify a suitable site and then submit a formal proposal for consideration.

Following these discussions, a comprehensive proposal, along with the identified site and requisition for the development of the multi-storey parking facility, is to be submitted to the Hon'ble Tourism Minister of Uttarakhand.

In this regard, the Board has already conducted several surveys. After scrutinizing all available sites, it has been determined that the most suitable location for the multi-storey parking facility is a group of adjacent sites, comprising Sy. No. 245-1, 245-5, and 245-6, with a total area of 0.349 acres (15,200 soft), classified as Class 'C' land.

The matter, along with all relevant documents, is now placed before the Board for approval of the identified site, which will then be included in the proposal to the Hon'ble Tourism Minister of Uttarakhand for further action.

Res.08 Board considered and pended the matter till next Board meeting.

09 <u>ENHANCEMENT OF HONORARIUM OF TEACHERS ON GROUND OF THEIR</u> TEACHING EXPERIENCE AT CANTONMENT BOARD CHAKRATA.

Reference Cantonment Board Chakrata CBR No. 03 dated 13/06/2024.

The Cantonment Board, vide the aforementioned CBR, proposed an agenda for the enhancement of honorarium for teachers based on their teaching experience. After detailed discussion, the Board directed the submission of clear recommendations with justifications.

This discrepancy in pay within the same organization, where teachers are receiving less than skilled labor, has been a matter of concern. Several requests have also been received from the teaching - staff regarding an enhancement of their honorarium.

Proposed Enhancement Based on Teaching Experience:

In light of these concerns and considering the natural tendency of employees to request periodic salary increments, it is suggested that reasonable hikes be granted based on the teachers' years of experience. This approach will help maintain pay hierarchy and reward experienced teachers for their dedication to the Board.

Office report:

To consider the request application of Shri Deepak Jugran, Junior Engineer (Outsourced), Cantonment Board Chakrata, dated 27/08/2024, for an enhancement of pay.

As per records, Shri Deepak Jugran has been working with the Cantonment Board Chakrata as an outsourced Junior Engineer on a monthly salary of Rs. 25,000/-. He has expressed that his current salary is insufficient to meet his family's needs, and as a result, he applied to various organizations offering better compensation. He has now received offers from a few organizations in Dehradun, offering him Rs. 30,000/- per month. Before accepting any new position, Shri Jugran has requested the CEO to consider increasing his salary to Rs. 30,000/- per month.

Considering Shri Jugran is a skilled and capable engineer, it is difficult to find an equally qualified replacement at a salary of Rs. 25,000/-. Additionally, the Cantonment Board is not in a position to handle the sudden change of a new engineer, as it typically takes 3 to 5 months for a new incumbent to fully adapt to the Board's work.

In the best interest of the Board, it is advisable that Shri Jugran's request be accepted.
