TERMS & CONDITIONS

TREE LOPPING, PRUNING AND DISPOSAL OF TREE MATERIAL CANTONMENT BOARD CHAKRATA

1. Scope of Work

The work shall include:

- Tree lopping, pruning, trimming and cutting of branches as directed by Cantonment Board Chakrata.
- Collection, segregation and removal of lopped branches, leaves and other tree waste.
- Loading, transportation and delivery of all lopped tree material to the designated location specified by Cantonment Board Chakrata.
- Deployment of all required labour, tools, machinery, vehicles, ropes, ladders and safety equipment.
- Compliance with all applicable statutory provisions, environmental regulations and safety standards.

The quoted rate shall be inclusive of all labour, transportation, equipment, taxes, duties and incidental charges.

2. Quantity Variation

The quantity of trees is as detailed in Annexure-A enclosed with this bid document. However, Cantonment Board Chakrata reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of trees or branches to be lopped based on actual site requirements without any claim for compensation by the bidder.

3. Site Inspection

Bidders are advised to inspect the site and assess the nature and extent of work before submitting their bids. No claim arising from lack of site knowledge shall be entertained after award of the contract.

4. Eligibility Criteria

The bidder should have experience in tree lopping, tree cutting, horticulture maintenance, landscaping, forestry works, or similar works during the last three years. (Exemptions to MSME bidders shall be governed by Government of India guidelines/orders.)

Documentary proof of such experience shall be uploaded with the bid, wherever applicable.

5. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

Bidders shall submit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amounting to ₹1,130 (2% of the estimated bid value of ₹56,500 approx) through the e-Chhawani Portal. Exemption for MSME bidders shall be applicable as per Government of India guidelines/orders.

6. Financial Standing

The bidder should not be under liquidation, insolvency, court receivership, bankruptcy or similar proceedings.

7. Documents to be Uploaded

The bidder shall upload the following documents:

- PAN Card
- GST Registration Certificate
- Aadhaar Card of Proprietor/Authorized Signatory
- Cancelled Cheque
- Bank Account Details/EFT Mandate
- Experience Certificate of similar works during the last three years (if applicable)
- EMD Receipt (if applicable)
- Affidavit/Self-Declaration stating that no environmental damage shall be caused during execution of the work
- Self-Declaration stating that, in the event of award of work, the bidder shall obtain all required permissions/NOCs from the Local Military Authority (LMA), Police Department or any other competent authority at his own cost and responsibility

8. Mandatory Documents

Failure to upload any document required under the bid document, ATC, corrigendum or these Terms & Conditions shall result in rejection of the bid.

9. GST and Taxes

The rates quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, labour cess, GST and any other statutory levies.

No additional payment on account of taxes or duties shall be admissible unless specifically provided in the contract.

10. Documents Required for Technical Evaluation

The following documents shall be uploaded in PDF format:

- PAN Card
- GST Registration Certificate
- Aadhaar Card of Proprietor/Authorized Signatory
- Cancelled Cheque
- Bank Account Details/EFT Mandate
- Experience Certificate of similar works (if applicable)
- EMD Receipt (if applicable)
- Environmental Protection Self-Declaration on letterhead.
- NOC Responsibility Self-Declaration on letterhead.
- Signed copy of the Terms & Conditions on the firm's letterhead as token of acceptance
- Non-blacklisted by any Government Agency Self-Declaration on letterhead.

Note: Exemptions to MSME bidders shall be governed by Government of India guidelines/orders.

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11. Safety Requirements

The successful bidder shall be solely responsible for the safety of workers, pedestrians and public property during execution of the work.

The bidder shall:

- Provide helmets, gloves, safety belts, ropes and other necessary safety equipment to workers.
- Follow all prescribed safety standards during tree lopping operations.
- Ensure that no damage occurs to nearby buildings, roads, electric lines, water pipelines, public utilities or adjacent trees.

Any loss or damage caused during execution of the work shall be made good by the contractor at his own cost.

12. Labour Law Compliance

The contractor shall comply with all applicable labour laws, minimum wage regulations and other statutory requirements.

The Cantonment Board shall not be responsible for any liability arising out of employment of labour by the contractor.

13. Completion Period

The work shall be completed within the time period specified in the Work Order.

In case of delay attributable to the contractor, the Cantonment Board may impose penalties and/or terminate the contract.

14. Disposal and Ownership of Tree Material

All lopped branches, wood, leaves and other tree waste shall remain the property of Cantonment Board Chakrata.

The successful bidder shall remove, transport and deliver the entire lopped material to the location directed by the Cantonment Board.

The contractor shall have no ownership rights, claim or interest over any tree material generated during execution of the work.

No material shall be left at the work site after completion of the work.

15. Site Visit

Prospective bidders may inspect the trees and work locations on any working day between 25 June 2026 and 30 June 2026 during office hours.

Venue: Office of the Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board Chakrata

Mode: Physical

Any clarification or corrigendum issued thereafter shall form part of the bid document.

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16. Payment Terms

Payment shall be released only after:

- Satisfactory completion of the tree lopping work.
- Removal and delivery of all lopped material to the designated location.
- Certification of satisfactory completion by the authorized officer of Cantonment Board Chakrata.

The invoice/bill shall be submitted in the name of:

17. Non-Blacklisting

The bidder shall furnish a self-declaration certifying that the firm has not been blacklisted, debarred or banned by any Central Government Department, State Government Department, PSU, Local Body or Autonomous Organization.

18. Right of Rejection

Cantonment Board Chakrata reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof and its decision shall be final and binding.

19. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts at Dehradun, Uttarakhand.

20. Acceptance of Terms & Conditions

The bidder shall submit a signed and stamped copy of these Terms & Conditions on the firm's letterhead as a token of acceptance of all conditions contained herein.

2. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
5. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. **Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. **Purchase Preference (Centre)**

Indian suppliers of this item are not allowed to participate and/ or compete in procurement by some foreign governments. Bidders / products from such countries are not eligible / not allowed to participate in this bid in terms of clause 1 (d) of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017

3. **Purchase Preference (Centre)**

Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 100% of total value.

4. **Purchase Preference (Centre)**

Purchase Preference linked with Local Content (PP-LC) Policy:

The bid clause regarding "Preference to Make In India products" stands modified in this bid and shall be governed by the PPLC Policy No. FP-20013/2/2017-FP-PNG dated 17.11.2020 issued by MoP&NG as amended up to date. Accordingly, bidders with Local Content less than or equal to 20% will be treated as "Non Local Supplier". The prescribed LC shall be applicable on the date of Bid opening. Sanctions on the bidders for false / wrong declaration or not fulfilling the Local Content requirement shall be as per the PPLC policy. Further following additional provisions are added in the certification and verification of local content provision of the Preference to Make in India clause:

- i. In case of foreign bidder, certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of their own office or subsidiary in India giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable. In case office or subsidiary in India does not exist or Indian office/subsidiary is not required to appoint statutory auditor or cost auditor, certificate from practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable.
- ii. Along with Each Invoice: The local content certificate (issued by statutory auditor on behalf of procuring company) shall be submitted along with each invoice raised. However, the % of local content may vary with each invoice while maintaining the overall % of local content for the total work/purchase of the pro-rata local content requirement. In case, it is not satisfied cumulatively in the invoices raised up to that stage, the supplier shall indicate how the local content requirement would be met in the subsequent stages.
- iii. The bidder shall submit an undertaking from the authorized signatory of bidder having the Power of Attorney along with the bid stating the bidder meets the mandatory minimum LC requirement and such undertaking shall become a part of the contract.

5. Purchase Preference (Centre)

Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Micro and Small Enterprises whose credentials are validated online through Udyog Aadhaar/URC for that product/service category. If the bidder wants to avail the reservation benefit, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. 8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.

However, in case of Service, if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement specific to said Service, then it will over-ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
