**05. DPR FOR SEWERAGE SYSTEM WITH STP IN CHAKRATA CANTONMENT AREA.**

Reference Cantonment Board Chakrata CBR NO. 07 dated 31/08/2024 and PDDE CC Lucknow Cantt letter No. 56786/Swachh Bharat/SHS/III/19 dated 27/02/2026 read with DG DE letter No. 76/68/Swachhata Hi Sewa/C/DE/2025 dated 27/02/2026.

**Office report:-**

Cantonment board Chakrata vide its CBR referred above approved the architectural and engineering firm M/s Horizon for preparation of DPR, providing designs and engineering services for Cantonment Fund Building.

As per the directions received from the higher authorities vide the letters referred above, the Cantonment Board Chakrata awarded the work for survey and preparation of DPR for STP network design in Chakrata Cantonment. Accordingly, the DPR amounting to Rs. 4,79,59,583.40/- has been prepared by M/s Horizon Design Consultants, 311 Madhav Complex, Dr. Yagnik Road, Rajkot. Further the DPR has also been vetted by the above firm through Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology, Surat and the DPR has been finalized.

In this connection the duly vetted DPR and all connected documents are placed before the Board for kind consideration and approval.

**Res.05** The Board considered and resolved another site visit of the proposed site in association with the consultant before approval of the DPR.

**06. RECLASSIFICATION OF THE CONCERNED CLASS B4 LAND FOR SEWERAGE SYSTEM WITH STP IN CHAKRATA CANTONMENT AREA.**

Reference PDDE CC Lucknow Cantt letter No. 56786/Swachh Bharat/SHS/III/19 dated 27/02/2026 read with DG DE letter No. 76/68/Swachhata Hi Sewa/C/DE/2025 dated 27/02/2026.

**Office report:-**

In compliance with directions of the higher authorities vide letters referred above, a work order was issued to M/s Horizon for preparation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for construction of an STP and associated sewerage network in Chakrata Cantonment.

As the proposed project site encompasses areas falling under Class C land as well as Class B-4 land currently under the management of the DEO, Dehradun, the Board is requested to consider and approve reclassification of the affected B4 land to Class-C land to facilitate execution of the project and for submission of proposal to the competent authority for obtaining necessary approval.

**Res.06** The Board considered and resolved another site visit of the proposed site in association with the consultant before approval of the DPR thereafter necessary proposal for reclassification will be submitted to the competent authority.

**07. ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION APPLICATION U/S 11(6) NO. 49 OF 2025.**

Reference order dated 08/05/2026 of the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand in ARBAP No. 49 of 2025 read with Preliminary Hearing order of Hon'ble Justice Rajesh Tandon dated 13/05/2026.

**Office report:**

Consequent upon the unfortunate demise of earlier appointed arbitrator on 26/11/2024, Shri Harjinder Pal Singh has filed an application seeking appointment of a substitute arbitrator. In this connection the Hon'ble High Court has proposed the name of Mr. Justice Rajesh Tandon, Retd. Judge as a Substitute Arbitrator.

Accordingly, In pursuance of the order dated 08/05/2026, the information has been sent to both parties by Hon'ble Justice Rajesh Tandon that the preliminary hearing will be conducted on 02/06/2026 at 12:30 PM at Flat No. 505, Green Heritage Apartment, Purkul Road, Dehradun Mussoorie Road Dehradun.

The previous Arbitration proceeding in this connection were handled by Shri Tarun Matta, Advocate on behalf of Cantonment Board Chakrata. **08. GRANT OF ENHANCED DEARNESS ALLOWANCE TO THE CANTONMENT FUND EMPLOYEES.**

To consider and approve grant of enhanced DA to the employees of Cantt. Board Chakrata from existing 58% to 60% w.e.f. 01/01/2026 as granted by the Govt. of Uttarakhand GO No. 396975/XXVII-10/2026-३-22807 dated 18/05/2026 to their employees The Cantonment Board employees are also eligible to get the said enhanced DA on the same terms & condition as per clause 14(1) of Memorandum of Settlement arrived at between Cantonment Board and their workman.

The financial implication for payment of above DA would be Rs. 24,052.00 (Approx.) per month, budget provision exists.

**Res.08** Considered and approved. The Board further resolved to submit necessary proposal to the competent authority for obtaining necessary sanctions.

**09. GRANT OF ENHANCED DEARNESS RELIEF TO THE CANTONMENT FUND PENSIONERS.**

To consider and approve grant of enhanced DR to the pensioners of Cantt. Board Chakrata from existing 58% to 60% w.e.f. 01/01/2026 as granted by the Govt. of Uttarakhand GO No. 396999/XXVII(10)/E-22807/2022 dated 18/05/2026 to their pensioners. The Cantonment Board pensioners are also eligible to get the said enhanced DR.

**Office report:**

The Cantonment Board Chakrata vide the letter referred above raised the concerns regarding the substandard quality of the open gym equipment supplied by M/s R.K. Enterprises.

In response, M/s R.K. Enterprises acknowledged that the quality of the supplied products was unsatisfactory and agreed to take back the supplied items without claiming any payment against GeM Contract No. GEMC-511687749859686 dated 29-12-2023 pertaining to **United Sports Emporium Multi Station Gym with 4 stations** (As per the GeM Invoice No. GEM -39170399 dated 27-01-2024 and GeM Contract No. GEMC-511687749859686 dated 29-12-2023)

Accordingly, the handing over and taking over of the aforementioned products, without any financial liability on the Cantonment Board Chakrata, has been carried out on 20/05/2026. In this connection all connected documents are placed before the Board for noting please.

**Officer report:-**

A building application from Antrim Zila Parishad , Dehradun bearing No. BPA-APP-CHAK-2026-02-18-007456 dated 21/02/2026 was received in the office of Cantonment Board Chakrata.

Subsequently, the Building Plan, Site plan and other requisite technical documents were scrutinized by the engineer section and the Junior Engineer, Cantonment Board Chakrata vide its report dated 26/02/2026 submitted that the proposed building is in accordance with the Building Bye-laws of Cantonment Board Chakrata.

In this connection, a NOC has also been obtained from the DEO Dehradun in respect of the land in question i.e. Sy. No. 336 described as Dak Bungalow classified as B-2 defence land under the management of District Board of State Govt. of Uttarakhand held under Proprietary Rights.

In continuation of the above, the necessary documentation and procedures were carried out by this office and the Revenue Superintendent and Junior Engineer, Cantonment Board Chakrata vide their report dated 03/06/2026 have confirmed that all the procedures have been duly completed and the fees in this regard has also been paid by the Antrim Zilla Parishad, Dehradun.

Accordingly, in compliance of section 234, 235 & 238 of Cantonments Act, 2006, the sanction letter for Building Plan alongwith all connected documents is placed before the Board for approval please.

**Res.15** The Board considered and approved the building plan as submitted vide Building Plan Approval Application no. BPA-APP-CHAK-2026-02-18-007456 dated 21/02/2026 in respect of SY. NO. 336 (Dak Bungalow).

**16. TENDER FOR PROVIDING OF ARCHITECT CUM ENGINEERING CONSULTANCY FIRM FOR APPOINTMENT OF CONSULTANT IN RENDERING DESIGN AND ENGINEERING SERVICE, PREPARATION OF DPR FOR PUBLIC WORKS FOR CANTONMENT BOARD CHAKRATA.**

To consider a total of thirteen bids received through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal (<https://gem.gov.in>) for providing of architect cum engineering consultancy firm for appointment of consultant in rendering design and engineering service, preparation of DPR for public works for Cantonment Board Chakrata. Technical bids of the same opened as per schedule mentioned in tender document and as per Technical Evaluation report dated 21-05-2026 and bidder representation dated 01/06/2026 out of total No. of 13 bidders, 05 bidders qualified and 08 bidders were disqualified for financial Evaluation of the bids. In the said process Technical evaluation committee scrutinize the bidder representation and finalized the technical evaluation. As per financial bid document Mathur Ugam & Associates, A-1/294, Second Floor, Safderjung Enclave, New Delhi - 110029, quoted lowest bid of Rs. 10,00,000.00 (2%) and was accordingly awarded L1 bidder by GeM portal.

**Office report:**

In compliance of the directions issued by the Board after carrying out various site surveys in Chakrata Cantonment, Cantonment Board Chakrata vide the letter referred above issued an order to M/s Horizon for feasibility of Multi storey parking at GLR Sy. No. 284 measuring 0.571 acres classified as B-4 land, described as 'Wooden Vacant land' under the Management of DEO Dehradun.

In this connection the proposed site was visited by the Architectural and Engineering firm M/s Horizon and after carrying out technical survey it was found that site is feasible for elevated parking.

Accordingly, the firm has submitted structural drawings for proposed parking in Cantonment Board Chakrata. In this connection the structural drawings as submitted by M/s Horizon are placed before the Board for noting and approval.

**Res.17** The Board considered the feasible structural drawings for construction of elevated parking on GLR Sy No 284 measuring 0.571 acres classified as B-4 land described

as 'Wooden Vacant land' and resolved to incorporate the adjoining area of Sy. No. 245/1, measuring 3,200 sqft, classified as Class C land described as 'Parking Ground' for maximizing the potential of proposed parking. The Board further resolved to submit comprehensive proposal to the competent authority for obtaining necessary approval and reclassification & change of purpose as 'Parking & Amenities'. The Board also resolved for modification of DPR and submission of finalized DPR for obtaining approval under original works.

In this connection, a copy of Order No. 01 dated 02/06/2026 of Hon'ble Justice Rajesh Tandon, Sole Arbitrator in Arbitration Application No. 49 of 2025 u/s 11(6) alongwith payment schedule is placed before the Board for approval and necessary action.
